## **Lifeline Screenings**

You are dust, and to dust you shall return. — Genesis 3:19

Each year, we spend the six weeks preceding Easter in a preparatory season called Lent. We enter that season on Ash Wednesday, on which it is customary for me to smear a cross of ashes on your forehead and remind you of your mortality. This year, we observe Ash Wednesday on February 14, which also happens to be Valentine's Day.

These two days do not, on the surface, seem to have all that much in common. There are all sorts of different feelings associated with Valentine's Day—from those who delight in showering their loved ones with heart-shaped chocolates and sentimental puns, to those skeptics who presume that Hallmark invented the holiday as an excuse to sell more cards. Wherever you land, you probably don't spend most Valentine's Days thinking about death.

Some of us think about death more than others, and what we think about death varies. If your job is even tangentially in the medical field, you probably encounter death an above-average amount. If one or more of your closest loved ones has died, you are familiar with the sting of grief. In our contemporary society, we are torn between the death-denying culture of anti-aging—this eye cream will change your life!—and the death-dealing realities of pandemic and war. Perhaps your thoughts on death—your own and others—have changed since 2020.

In observance of this reflective, penitential, funereal time of Lent, our after-worship Community Time together is going to be centered around the idea of A Good Death. Each Sunday during this season (February 18-March 17) we'll gather around a different facet of death, with facilitators from our community. There's a flier in this newsletter with the specifics for each Sunday, and I'll be telling you more about them during the announcements each week, but I want to issue you a more specific invitation.

If learning about death—hospice care, grief resources, palliative care, end-of-life financial planning, and funeral planning—sounds uncomfortable, I invite you to sit with that discomfort and push through that discomfort. The logistics of death are complex, and feeling prepared to navigate them—before you are in the midst of grief—can be empowering. Knowing the options, prayerfully considering them, and even making some preliminary choices can alleviate some of the stress you are likely to experience at the end of the life of someone you love. You can also alleviate that stress from your kids (or other next of kin) by preparing for your own death.

Morbid, I know! But that is the gift of this season. It is as good a time as any to face these facts, and do so in community. God created each of us to live together in love—which always results in being separated by death, but reunited in resurrection joy. Once Lent begins, we'll have to refrain from the associated hallelujahs, but we will still be celebrating the God who loves us. Perhaps we can thank God for this love with a valentine?

## **Council Update**

Hello SMLC!

Here are the updates from the January Council meeting:

The Council met on January 17th for our regular monthly meeting. The Council accepted and/or approved the submitted minutes and reports.

- I presented the main plans and objectives for the Council for 2024:
  - 1) Enable our committees, chairpersons, and members,
  - 2) Resolve remaining property and infrastructure issues,
  - 3) Ensure financial stability,
  - 4) Review and revise the Continuing Resolutions.

The Council also considered 2 items of new business:

- the Council approved the proposed budget and forwarded it to the congregation for approval at the February 11th congregational meeting.
- The Council also approved a plan for the funds invested in an ELCA Mission Investment Fund Certificate of Deposit to transfer the earned interest to our general operating funds, and to re-invest the principal in another 1-year certificate of deposit. This will give the Council time to review the best options for longterm use of the principal funds.

Thank you for the opportunity to serve as president for 2024 and for your continued support of SMLC, our Council, Pastor Casey, and the staff.


